

**Pandemic Physical Distancing Protocol at Deep Springs (ver. 7, June 15 2020)**

	<p><b>Group 1 - Have been at Deep Springs, and practicing social distancing from anyone outside of Group 1, for at least 14 days</b></p>	<p><b>Group 2 - Group 3 members may request Group 2 status from the Covid Committee. Outside contact during last 14 days limited to Eastern Sierra including appropriate physical distancing, AND anyone living with a group 2 person (i.e. sharing a dorm room, bathroom, or home)</b></p>	<p><b>Group 3 - DEFAULT FOR ANYONE COMING TO DEEP SPRINGS FROM OUTSIDE THE VALLEY, or anyone who has had visitors in their residence, AND anyone living with a group 3 person (i.e. sharing a dorm room, bathroom, or home) Requires 14-day isolation before entering Group 1</b></p>
<p><b>Carrying, Wearing, and Washing Masks (For All Groups)</b></p>	<p>County Health Orders, as well as common sense and college policy, requires wearing a mask in any indoor space except your residence or personal office. For the foreseeable future, we will have to carry masks with us and get used to using them outside of our residence, when inside or close to others (i.e. in the food serving line). Reusable masks should be washed at least daily, and more often if dirty. Handwash with soap, hang to dry. It's best to rotate at least two masks.</p>		
<p><b>Building entry/conditions for Main Building and Museum</b></p>	<p>Entry okay except MB basement or spaces signed for Group 3; masks required inside of all buildings except your residence. <p><b>Method of service</b></p>	<p>Served outside through museum window; please come ontime to meals. Latecomers and second helping will be served approximately 20-25 minutes after meal initiation, marked by a ringing of the bell. NO SELF SERVICE.</p>

<p><b>Food space access</b></p>	<p>Kitchen trailer okay after washing hands and wearing a mask. Entry to food trailers and leftover fridge and shelves ONLY after WASHING HANDS and wearing a MASK. No access to museum porch fridge.</p>	<p>No Entry to Kitchen trailer. Food trailers and leftover fridge and shelves ONLY after WASHING HANDS and wearing a MASK. In group bathroom, you must wear gloves and wipe down surfaces (door handles, toilet handles, sink area) with sanitizer AFTER USE with clean or gloved hands AND LEAVE DOOR OPEN FOR VENTILATION

<b>Vehicles</b>		Only with others in Group 1 with masks	Not with any group 1 or group 3 members. Sharing vehicle with another group 2 member is not recommended and synchronizes the 14-day clocks to most recent exposure. Sanitizing of all surfaces touched at end of trip required.		No riding in in vehicles with others outside your residence group. No riding in vehicles shared with other people outside your residence group.	
<b>Limits to soccer &amp; other outdoor activities (excluding hiking, which is encouraged for all so long as social distancing is practiced)</b>		Soccer and other activities allowed	ONLY while maintaining 6 ft. distance from others at all times. Members of these groups are asked to be extra careful to avoid injuries that would lead to anyone outside of their residence group assisting them.
